As we have shared before, we feel a definite leading toward beginning a high school ministry that will incorporate aviation and the Gospel as an outreach into various public high schools. Involved with that we also felt that Daniel needed some additional training once finished with school, the most important being to get his CFI (Certified Flight Instructor) rating so he can train young men and women that show an interest in aviation. He went to the Marion Airport (where he had began training at 18) in Iowa to talk with them about getting the training needed. As the conversation developed they were very intrigued by his desire to outreach to high school kids. They want him to start in the summer as soon as Moody is done because right now they have more students than the can handle. This was a definite answer to prayer and we are very excited to train with them! Once the training is done (should only take a month or two) Daniel will be able to work with them for employment . At the same time he will begin to make connections with the local high schools.

We have made some invaluable connections in the Christian community and we are beginning to see some pretty amazing plans begin to develop. Not all the details can be shared now as some are still in the dreaming and birthing stage, but there will certainly be good news to follow. We see the ministry we are involved in beginning locally but we believe it is God's plan to do much more with it as we remain faithful to Him and His calling.

We have also been invited to take a teaching position at our local church in Iowa. This is something that has been on Daniel's heart for some time. Lastly our church was offered up as a place for youth to hang out and grow so we see the aviation ministry branching into our local church, as a place for discipleship for those exiting their old life.
